# NORTH BENNET STREET SCHOOL

North Bennet Street School was incorporated in 1885 as the North Bennet Street Industrial School in Boston's North End to help immigrants adjust to their new country. Pauline Agassiz Shaw, the school's founder, was committed to teaching the skills needed for immigrants to obtain employment.

Today, North Bennet Street School's mission is to train students in traditional trades that use hand skills in concert with evolving technology, to preserve and advance craft traditions and to promote greater appreciation of craftsmanship. The school offers full-time courses in Bookbinding, Cabinet & Furniture Making, Carpentry, Jewelry Making & Repair, Locksmithing, Piano Technology, Preservation Carpentry, and Violin Making & Repair.

In each program, highly skilled instructors teach students in small classes, sharing their knowledge and talent. Students graduate as well-qualified professionals with proficiency in a chosen trade or craft.
